



From Pastor Matt

Over the last couple of years, I have served as a member of the Northeast Iowa Synod Council. I am the liaison between the council and one of their local network groups that focuses on our synod's work as part of the global Lutheran Church.

On August 24, I helped to support a daylong event called the **"Global Church Together**"

Festival" - which took place at Trinity Lutheran Church in Mason City. It was a terrific event and there were well over 100 people participating from throughout the synod (mainly from the western side of the synod, since Mason City is a fair distance from Dubuque.)



Over the course of the day there were workshops, breakout groups, and presentations that highlighted our synod's work in the global church, specifically along with **our two companion churches: the Lutheran Church in Hungary** and **the Lutheran Church in Namibia**.

Our keynote speaker was Rev. Dr. Themba Mkhabela, who serves as the ELCA regional representative for Southern Africa, including Namibia. Located on the Southwest coast of Africa, Namibia is home to over 400,000 Lutherans. *Northeast lowa has had a long history of partnering with Namibia, and helped to end Apartheid rule in in 1990.*

We also had updates and information on a recent synod delegation to visit the Lutheran Church in Hungary. The church in Hungary dates back to the 1500s, and today has about 170,000 members. We learned about the current work of the church in Hungary, and were also given a Hungarian cooking demonstration! (Think Paprika!)

In future months I hope to share with you some of the amazing history of St. Peter's work in global ministry. As many of you know, two of our previous pastors, Mark Thomsen and Bonnie Jensen, both served as the directors of the ELCA Global Missions. It's an incredible legacy, and a great model of how St. Peter can share the Gospel beyond our building and literally all over the world!

You might think that once a Pastor or Deacon is finished with seminary that their education is finished. **That is not true**. I think all people, in all fields, continue to learn and grow, and Rostered Leadership is no different.

Each year we are given the opportunity to experience continuing education to help us in our ministry. For myself, as a First Call Pastor I have the opportunity to choose some of my own continuing education, as well as participate in the Synod planned continuing education for first call Rostered Leaders.

In May, I participated in my first chosen continuing education, in the form of **The Festival of Homiletics.** It is a conference that brings over 1,000 preachers from all over the country together each year, to explore preaching and worship and be inspired and fed by the preachers who lead and the worship services that participants experience.

It was through that experience that I was able to connect with the people who are leading a Compelling Preaching Cohort through Luther Seminary and a Lilly Grant. I mentioned in my recent sermon, that it is giving me the opportunity to learn from, and with, a diverse group of preachers. One of the first things we talked about when we gathered for our first meeting, was that it difficult to define compelling preaching, and **it is important to remember that in our preaching we are pointing to a Compelling God!**

During this journey with this cohort I will be asking for some help from the congregation, so please watch for those opportunities to help learn about what compelling preaching is and how we can share that with preachers all over.




